The theme for the exhibition is: **From Between the Pages**. Artists may like to take inspiration from books, stories, storytelling, poetry, reading, authors, etc.

There are three categories for entries: 12 years and under, 13 – 17 years and Open.

People's Choice awards will be given in each category for a winner and two runners up. Prizes have been kindly donated by Arc Framerite in Bellerive, adArt in North Hobart, Artery in Hobart, and Doggos on Shelomith in Acton.

There will be three People's Choice Awards in each category. Voting will run from Monday 7 November until Friday 25 November. Winners will be announced on Monday 28 November.

- Winners will receive a \$100 voucher and certificate
- Second runners-up will receive a \$50 cash prize and certificate

There will also be a Packing Room Prize chosen by Rosny Library staff. The winner will receive a \$25 voucher and certificate.

- 2. Artists must live, study or work on Hobart's eastern shore.
- 3. There are three categories: 12 years and under, 13 17 years and Open.

- 4. By submitting an entry to this competition, you:
 - a. confirm that you are the entrant's parent or legal guardian, unless entrant is 18 years of age or over
 - b. consent to your child entering this competition
 - c. accept these terms and conditions of entry.
- 5. All entries must be submitted via email using the entry form below and include a jpg or png photograph of the artwork. Please contact Rosny Library if you need help with this.
- 6. Artists may have their artwork for sale. If the artwork is for sale, their email address, webpage, Facebook page or Instagram handle will be included with the price on the display label. Interested people can contact the artist direct. Rosny Library will not be involved with any sales or take enquiries on behalf of artists.
- 7. Each artist may submit one artwork only.
- 8. Artwork must be the original and uncopied work of the artist and created in the last 12 months.
- 9. Artwork may be two or three dimensional and can be in any style, form or medium. It must have a title and respond to the theme. Unfortunately, digital and video/multi-media works cannot be accepted as Rosny Library doesn't have the capacity to display them.
- 10. 2D works to be a maximum of 300mm x 420mm (A3) including frame.
- 11. Artworks must be ready to hang or display. All framed works and works on canvas must have hooks and wire installed. Children's work on paper does not need to be framed.
- 12. 3D works are encouraged and may be accepted subject to size. Limited display space is available. Please contact Rosny Library for more information.
- 13. Artists will be notified by email on or before Friday 28 October 2022 if their work has been accepted for display. Acceptance of entries and display of the works shall be at the discretion of Rosny Library. Rosny Library reserves the right to refuse any entry or refuse to display any work. The curators' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 14. Artwork must be delivered in person to Rosny Library, 46 Bligh Street, Rosny Park, Room 3 on Thursday 3 November 2022 between 9.30 am 12.00 pm and 2.00 pm 5.00 pm.
- 15. Artists must collect their work from Room 3 at Rosny Library on Friday 2 December 2022 between 9.30 am 12.00 pm and 2.00 pm 5.00 pm. **Please note artworks cannot be stored at Rosny Library.** If you are unable to pick up your artwork on time, please contact Alison Triffett or Alex Holmes on 6165 6447.
- 16. Artists are responsible for the insurance of artworks and the delivery and collection of artworks. Rosny Library will not be responsible for any loss or damage, however caused.
- 17. Rosny Library may require winners or their parent or legal guardian to provide evidence of the winner's identity, including their work, school or educational institution, or residential address.

Rosny Library collects personal information about entrants while running this exhibition and does so in accordance with its privacy policy at Tasmanian Government Personal Information Protection (www.tas.gov.au).
